

## *Canon John Adams*

I work for Falmouth and Exeter University's Archive Service and I am currently investigating a small collection of materials belonging to Canon John H Adams.

I understand that he was a member of the OCS (I have a letter saying he was re-elected to the committee in 1949) and I was wondering if you have any useful information that could be passed on about him. I have pieced together certain facts from notes in his letters such as his wife and son's names, where he lived throughout his life (Landulph, St Austell, St Agnes), and I believe I have found him referred to on a 1901 census at 4 years old, although I have no firm evidence to support this. I believe he died in 1985.

However I am attempting to write a short biography of his life and work as a covering page for our online Archive and I would appreciate any leads that you may be able to provide.

The materials we hold were donated via the Institute of Cornish Studies and include some of his work on Theodore Paleologus, and several files of materials detailing medieval chapels in Cornwall.

I would be very grateful for any help you can offer.
