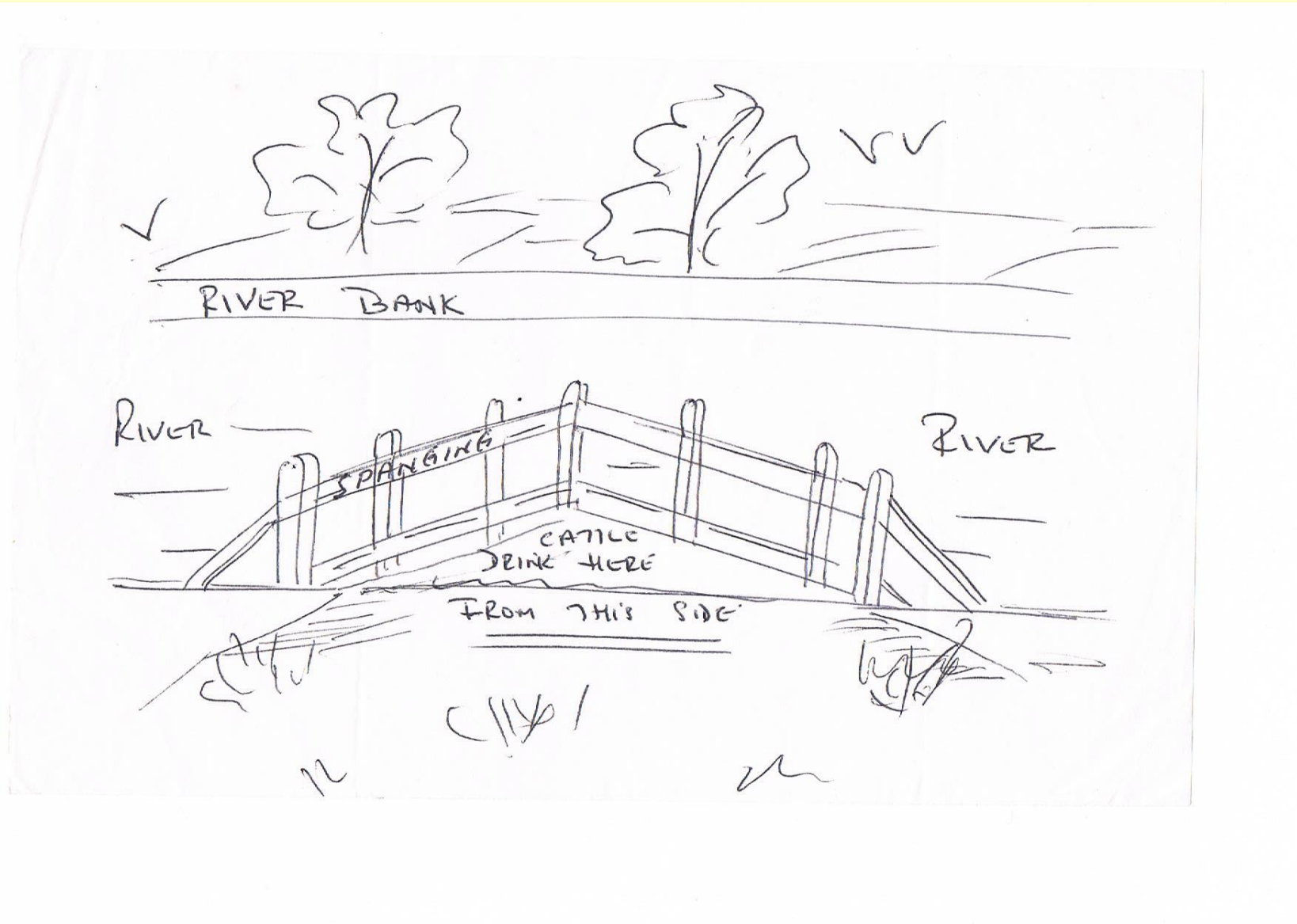


Spanging

The sketch clearly illustrates the use and purpose of the fence as a means of allowing animals to drink from a stream or rill, without them gaining access to the meadow on the other side, which just might even be in someone else's ownership.
